COVID UPDATE – Today, we've received confirmation of two more positive Covid cases amongst the children, taking the total to 6 in the past few weeks. When we receive news of a new case we send an email to parents of the class/es concerned to inform them, together with information from the Local Authority's Public Health Team and guidance from the DFE. So, no letter, no cases in your child's class! Lateral Flow Tests are not always accurate, so if your child has a cough (or any other Covid type symptoms) and a negative Lateral Flow result, we would ask you to get a confirmatory PCR test for them before they return to school please.

MEDICINES IN SCHOOL – If your child needs to take a prescribed medicine or Calpol, please try to time the doses so that they are not during the school day. We know that this is not always possible, but if your child does need medicine in school, staff will not be able to administer it unless you have completed an Administration of Medicines form available from the office, or emailed the office giving your permission and stating the name of the medicine and dosage required. This is for legal reasons as staff are not required to give medicine to your child and only do so on a voluntary basis. ALL medicines should be given to your child's teacher or handed into the office. PLEASE, NEVER PUT ANY MEDICINES IN YOUR CHILD'S BAG.

HARVEST FESTIVAL – We'll be holding our Harvest Festival next Thursday 7th October in school rather than in church as we originally hoped, so we are sorry that you will be unable to join us. The children have done some Harvest paintings which will be displayed in the church, so please do pop in and have a look at them!

Our Harvest collection is for the Market Harborough Food Bank and they particularly want the items listed below. Contributions can be brought into school from tomorrow onwards. Thank you in advance for your generosity.

Most Needed items: cartons of long life semi skimmed milk, tinned meat/ chicken, biscuits, cereals, coffee (90g), long grain rice (500g), sugar (500g), crackers, toothpaste, deodorant, fruit juice, corned beef, tinned: fruit, rice pudding, veg (not peas, carrots, potatoes or tomatoes), instant mashed potato, other beans eg chickpeas, kidney NOT baked beans
