

Hallaton C of E Sports Premium Funding 2013/14

Funding was allocated to all maintained and state sector schools with 17 or more primary phase children from September 2013 to August 2014 at a rate of £8000 per school plus £5 per child on roll, totalling £8530. We were awarded £5147 from September 2013 to March 2014.

This funding must be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sporting provision. At Hallaton CE Primary we have used our money to:

Buy into the Schools Sports Partnership organised by Rutland County Council

Hire specialist PE teachers or qualified coaches to work with our teachers and teaching assistants during PE lessons.

Provide resources and training courses for our staff.

Run sport competitions and increase pupil participation in PE and games activities.

Pay for transport to competitions and sports development activities.

Our expenditure from September 13 – March 14 is as follows:
