All classes took part in a Science Day on Thursday. KS1 went to Forest School to bug hunt and identify micro-habitats. Maple Class were outside learning about the Water Cycle and created their own micro Water Cycle - have a look at their class windows! They also discussed the importance of water and how not to waste it. Willow Class did the following experiments to consolidate their learning from the year;

Investigating yeast reaction - placing balloon on test tubes that contained different concoctions to see how much the balloon will inflate.

Finger prints - looking at the different types of finger prints.

Aerodynamics - making paper airplanes to see how aerodynamics work.

Bridges - using understanding of physics to build and design bridges to hold the most weight.

Food chains - looking at different creatures / plants & the transfer of energy & nutrients from one to another.
