NEWSLETTER – IMPORTANT INFORMATION

As you know we do a Newsletter virtually every Friday of the year with the aim of informing you what is going on in school and giving you other general information. The letter is sent electronically via Parentmail and we have always produced a hard copy too. For the next few weeks, our new families will receive a hard copy until the Parentmail system is upgraded. **This year we intend to send the Newsletter by Parentmail only unless you specifically request a hard copy. If you have changed your email address, please let us know as it will be our primary point of contact with you. UNIFORM PE KIT AND BAGS

PLEASE ensure all your children's uniform is named. This is important, as one sweatshirt can look very like another when it's not on its owner! Likewise, for PE kit which should consist of: white t-shirts/polo shirt, navy shorts/skort/plimsolls/trainers separate socks, PE jumper (other than school jumper), jogging bottoms or tracksuit for winter and be brought into school on a Monday morning and taken home for laundering on a Friday afternoon please.

We have very limited space in school, so could we please ask that your child does not bring a large rucksack into school. Their bags should be small enough to fit into lockers for the older children or hang on their peg without encroaching in the next one.

SWIMMING – EYFS TO Y3

This year the children will be swimming at Uppingham School Pool, commencing next Tuesday 3rd September. All children will need to have a swimming hat (fabric ones are easier to put on) and bring their swimming kit in on a Tuesday morning. It makes changing for the younger children much easier if they wear something loose like jogging bottoms when the weather gets cooler. No tights please for the girls!

MONEY TO SCHOOL

Any money sent to school should be handed into the office. We don't offer online payments as there is an additional cost to the school, but are happy to accept cheques or cash – which should always be in a named envelope marked with what the money is for.

School dinners have to be ordered in advance, so we need at least a week's notice of any changes. The school budget is charged £2.30/meal for the Universal Free Infant School Meals (UIFSM), so if you know your child won't be in school on a specific day, please let us know so that we can adjust the order and ensure we don't pay for a meal that it not taken. We do understand that with illness this isn't always possible. For parents who pay for lunches, the Local Authority's policy is that they should be paid for in **ADVANCE**. We also need to know if your child won't be in school. You will be credited for lunches not taken, provided we have been informed beforehand.

We are happy to accept payments on a weekly, monthly or termly basis – even for the whole year if that's what you want to do! Amounts are as follows:
