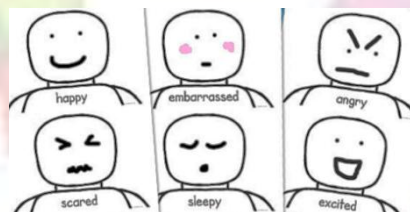
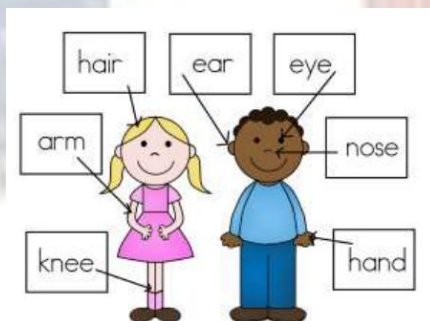

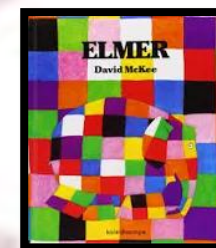

Our key texts: Elmer and the Colour Monster. We will use these books to explore the 7 areas of the EYFS curriculum.

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Our Learning Sequence		
Week 1		This week the children will learn the rules and routines of school and begin to explore their classroom areas. They will spend time getting to know each other and the teacher spending time getting to know them. They will begin their phonic lessons and practice writing their name.
Week 2		This week the children will be making close observations of their face and painting their very own portraits. They will start forest school session and begin by exploring their new outdoor space, the boundaries to keep them safe. The children will also begin maths lessons and focus on a number a day.
Week 3		This week children will be mixing colours to paint their very own colour monster for their puppet show! The children will use natural materials to show different emotions by making their own faces.
Week 4		The children will begin to talk about patterns and measure in Maths as well as learn some tricky words in phonics. They will also be exploring how to combine different materials to junk model houses.
Week 5		Through the story of 'Elmer' children will be learning and creating patterns! They will discuss what makes them unique and why that is important. They will explore the art technique creating colourful collages.
Week 6		Children will begin to write some CVC words to describe Elmer, as well as begin to be confident in the numbers 1-3. They will focus on 'changes from a baby' and compare themselves from when they were a baby through photos.
Week 7		This week in our final week of the topic, the children will focus on 'our community.' We will spend time creating maps of our village and getting out to explore our local community by following the maps we have made.
