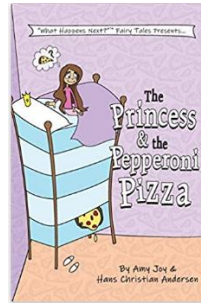
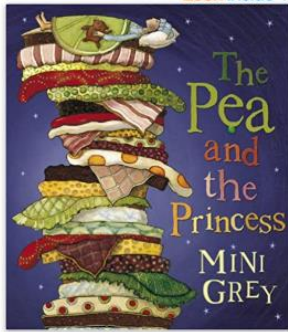


Year 1 - English - King of the Castle!

Developing Writing Skills

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

- Use spaces between my words.

- Use phonics sounds that I have been taught to sound out and spell words independently.
- Spell words from phonic phases 2,3 ,4 and 5 correctly in independent writing.
- To spell verbs with -ed and -ing suffixes.
- To spell comparative words with -er and -est suffixes.
- Use a word book to support spelling of "tricky words" when writing.

Poetry

Reading poetry aloud, Writing a poem

- To listen to and recite a poem in a group.
- Begin to use rhythm and intonation when reading aloud.
- To identify rhyming words within a poem.
- To write an alternative verse using own ideas with the help of a writing frame.
