Good luck to all our children who will be representing Rutland in tomorrow's Cross Country finals.

Congratulations to everyone in Y5 for the amazing Viking Longships they have made – please come and see them in the Y5 classroom.

Next Tuesday our Y6 children will be visiting Parliament and the London Eye and on Friday the Y4 will be experiencing a World War 2 Evacuation Day at Holdenby House – details of both trips have already been sent.

**PARENTS EVENINGS** – attached on Parentmail is a form for you to complete indication when you would like an appointment with your child's teacher. You can print or email the form, which should be returned to the office please. The meetings will be held during the week beginning Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March – please note Y6 parent/child meetings have already taken place, so there will be no Y6 meetings.

**PARENT GOVERNOR ELECTION** - also attached on Parentmail are details asking for nominations for the two parent governor vacancies that are coming up. If you are interested in becoming a governor, please request a nomination pack from the office. **The closing date for completed nominations is Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March.**

**WORLD BOOK DAY – Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March** – we would like all the children to come to school next Thursday dressed as a character from a book please (no football or rugby strips please). Your child will be bringing home a £1 book token valid until 29<sup>th</sup> March and we hope you will have fun helping your child choose a book.

**CORONA VIRUS** – we are continuing to promote good hand hygiene in school and rely on your support to do so at home. It would be helpful if the children could bring into school a small packet of tissues that they can use during the day if needed. If you wish your child could bring a flannel in each day to use as their own individual hand towel, to be kept in a named bag. Please note that it must be renewed daily.

The latest guidance is that anyone visiting a **Category 1 country**: Wuhan city and Hubei Province (Cambodia, Iran China\* Daegu or Cheongdo (Republic of Korea) Hong Kong and any Italian town under containment measures is to self-isolate, even if asymptomatic, and call NHS 111 to inform of recent travel. Go home or to your destination and then self isolate. **Category 2 countries**: Japan, Laos, Macau, Malaysia, Myanmar, Republic of Korea\* ,Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, Vietnam, Cambodia, China, Hong Kong and Northern Italy. Travellers do not need to undertake any special measures, but if they develop symptoms they should self-isolate and call NHS 111. The guidance for Italy, Iran, Daegu or Cheongdo (Republic of Korea), Laos, Myanmar, Cambodia and Vietnam applies

to individuals who returned from these specific areas on or after 19 February 2020. Detailed maps are available on the Government's website.
