HOLIDAYS IN TERM-TIME

The Local Authority has revised their guidance on term-time holiday and has asked us to notify you of the updated guidance:

"The School and its staff regard the regular attendance of children at school as being vital to each child's education and development. It is for this reason that non-attendances (however short or infrequent) are treated seriously. It remains the policy of the school to only sanction nonattendance during term time in exceptional circumstances.

If your child has unauthorised leave of absence you may either be issued with a Penalty Notice of ± 120 per parent per child (discounted to ± 60 if paid within 21 days) or your case could be referred by the Local Authority directly to the Magistrates' Court for the purposes of a criminal prosecution.

Good attendance is considered to be 96% or above with no unauthorised absences".

Unfortunately, illness and holidays combined can quickly take attendance below the 96% threshold. Whilst good attendance is encouraged, there are some illnesses that do require a minimum amount of time off school to prevent the spread of infection to other children. A list of recommended times off school for the most common illnesses is below.

| German Measles | 6 days from onset of rash |
| Impetigo | Until crusted over and healed or 48 hours after antibiotics are started |
| Scarlet Fever | 24 hours after commencing antibiotics |
| Diarrhoea and/or | 48 hours from last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting |
| Vomiting | |
| Flu | Until recovered |
| Whooping Cough | 5 days after starting antibiotics or 21 days from onset if no antibiotics |
| Mumps | 5 days after onset of swelling |

SWIMMING GOGGLES - a large number of children are wearing swimming goggles. This is not necessary or encouraged, especially for the younger children who are in the smaller pools and not swimming lengths.
