We wanted to take a moment to share some of the fantastic learning experiences our students have been enjoying recently.

In EYFS, the children have been having a blast learning about freezing and melting. They enjoyed a fun activity where they had to rescue penguins from the ice as quickly as possible! It was a lovely way to explore this exciting science topic.

Meanwhile, Beech class was all about celebrating Welsh culture! They indulged in delicious Welsh cakes and played a lively game of Welsh Bingo, which certainly added an extra flair to their week.
